Webb Winery Awarded Eight Medals at 2015 Pennsylvania Farm Show in Harrisburg
Third Annual "Wine & Chocolate" event begins February 5th

When you visit Webb Winery in Hermitage, not only will you likely visit with the owners and the winemaker, you will also be tasting some of the best wines Pennsylvania has to offer! The results are in for the 2015 Pennsylvania Farm Show Wine Competition, and Webb Winery has been awarded eight medals over several different categories, including a Gold medal for their Fredonia wine. A total of 52 wineries submitted wines to this year's competition and only 14 gold medals were awarded. Other medals won by Webb Winery are Silver Medals for Apple and Chardonee wines and Bronze Medals for Chambourcin, Concord, Pear, Vidal Blanc and Zoe wines.

Webb Winery's awards were announced just as the Hermitage establishment is gearing up for its Third Annual "Wine & Chocolate" event coming in February. The event will take place February 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, and 14, and is a fun and delicious combination of Webb Winery wines and Philadelphia Candies chocolates. For \$12 per person, the Webbs invite you to experience the unique way that properly pairing these two culinary treats will actually enhance the flavors of both the wine and the chocolate.

You can visit Webb Winery to taste and purchase their award-winning wines at 2531 S. Hermitage Rd (Rt. 18) just south of the intersection of route 518 and less than a mile north of I-80 and I-376.

Webb Winery is located in a small space, but has a wine for every palate. Varieties include reds, whites, blushes and fruit wines with a wide array of flavors and sweetness levels. Since opening in 2012, Webb Winery has cultivated relationships with local farms that grow outstanding grapes, apples and other fruits. These suppliers include the Apple Castle in New Wilmington, and Klenz Farms and John Schultz & Sons, both located in North East, PA.
